Also send official transcripts of any college work you have completed.</li> </ul>	☐ Transfer students must have an overall grade point average of 2.0 or higher. Some majors require a higher GPA and completion of certain academic requirements. If possible, apply for admission a full semester before your admissions deadline but no later than August 1 for the fall semester or December 1 for the spring semester.
Students who have graduated within the last five years or whose expected graduation date was within the past five years must submit ACT or SAT scores. When you register for the ACT or SAT, arrange for them to report your scores to WVU (ACT 4540 and SAT 5904). If you've already taken the ACT or SAT but didn't specify that WVU receive your scores, contact ACT or SAT and request to have your score sent to WVU. This can also be done on their websites. WVU combines the highest sub-scores from different test dates to create a "superscore" total or composite for admissions and scholarship consideration eligibility.
